Join the UAFA Picket Protest Against the Ongoing Discrimination of Adjunct Faculty at EWU!

The UAFA along with the National Education Association/Illinois Education Association (NEA/IEA) and other supportive organizations representing college faculty will stage a picket demonstration in opposition to EWU Chancellor Mohammad Khan and Provost Madhu Jain arbitrary mass firing and abrogation of adjunct faculty. Their actions must be condemned and publically exposed! **The majority African American and Latino student population at EWU deserve better treatment!**

The adjunct faculty at EWU is the largest workforce at the university. EWU's overreliance on adjunct faculty makes its core grievances undeniably relevant. During the Spring Quarter 2010, there were fifty-six adjunct faculty members and only twelve full-time faculty members. There is no tenure at EWU. The UAFA plans to vote for NEA/IEA labor union representation in the Fall Quarter 2010. The Chancellor and Provost continue to fire experienced adjunct faculty who were instrumental in organizing the UAFA. Their actions are staunchly against our nation's long standing labor laws. The UAFA members are paid a fraction of the wages that others are paid for teaching the very same classes and work under very restricting and threatening contracts that leave them with no job security whatsoever.
